Special references to the cow are found in the Padma Purana, Skanda Purana, Agni Purana, Mahabharata, and Bhagavata Purana. In particular, the Padma Purana states that the Vedas reside in the cow's mouth, Vishnu and Shankara in its horns, and Kartikeya in its abdomen. Additionally, the Bhagavata Purana highlights the importance of cows in Krishna's pastimes, while the Skanda Purana considers cow dung, urine, milk, curd and ghee to be sacred.

The Garuda Purana considers the cow to be very sacred, and its service is considered an important means of attaining salvation. Donating a cow is especially helpful in crossing the Vaitarani River after death. Donating a cow bestows great merit upon a person. And he is spared the tortures of hell. Furthermore, visiting a cowshed, seeing a cow, and seeing milk and cow urine are also considered auspicious and virtuous.

To provide permanent shelter with nutritious fodder, clean water, and hygienic conditions for abandoned and rescued cows.


O3 Awareness & Devotion:



1. Cow Rescue Operations

Our rescue operations are the foundation of our mission. Whenever we receive information about a cow being injured, abandoned, or trapped in a dangerous situation—such as road accidents, ditches, or construction sites—our team immediately responds. We ensure the cow

is carefully transported to safety, often in collaboration with local authorities or volunteers. Each rescue mission is handled with utmost care, love, and urgency, ensuring that no cow is left unattended or in pain. Through these efforts, Shree Hari Gau Sewa Sansthan has saved countless lives and continues to stand as a trusted name in Gau Raksha (cow protection).






2. Medical Treatment & Healthcare

After rescue, the next crucial step is medical treatment. Many cows we find are severely injured, malnourished, or suffering from infections. We provide proper veterinary care, medicines, vaccinations, and regular health checkups. In serious cases, our team coordinates with nearby animal

hospitals for surgeries and specialized treatment. We also maintain a stock of essential medicines and first-aid supplies to ensure immediate help is always available. Our ultimate goal is to see every rescued cow fully recover and live a healthy, painfree life under our care.







3. Shelter & Care Management

Our Gau Shalas (cow shelters) are designed to provide rescued and abandoned cows a safe and comfortable home. These shelters are equipped with proper sheds to protect them from heat, cold, and rain, as well as clean resting areas and hygienic feeding zones.

Our volunteers and caretakers ensure that every cow receives love, cleanliness, and care every single day. Many cows that cannot return to the streets or farms spend their lives peacefully in our shelters, surrounded by compassion and respect. Our shelters are not just physical spaces—they are sanctuaries of love and protection.






4. Feeding & Fodder Arrangement

One of our daily responsibilities is to ensure that all cows in our care have access to fresh and nutritious food. We provide a balanced diet that includes green grass, dry fodder, grains, and jaggery. During difficult times such as droughts or winters, we also arrange special feeding drives to

support other stray cows in nearby villages. No cow under our supervision ever sleeps hungry. We believe feeding a cow is one of the purest forms of seva (service), and our volunteers participate joyfully in this divine act every day.









5. Rescue from Accidents & Difficult Spots

Cows often get stuck in drains, fall into pits, or face road accidents, especially in urban and semi-urban areas. Our rescue team works tirelessly day and night to reach such locations and bring these innocent beings to safety. Equipped with ropes, stretchers, and vehicles, our trained volunteers perform quick and safe rescues, ensuring minimal stress to the

animal.

Many such rescues have saved cows from life-threatening situations and restored their faith in human kindness.







6. Awareness & Community Engagement Programs

We firmly believe that true change begins with awareness. Shree Hari Gau Sewa Sansthan regularly conducts awareness programs, seminars, and Gau Sewa camps in schools, villages, and cities to educate people about cow protection and animal welfare. We encourage individuals and communities to participate in Gau Sewa, adopt rescued cows, and support shelters through donations or

volunteer work. By spreading knowledge about the spiritual, cultural, and ecological importance of cows, we aim to build a compassionate society where every being is treated with love and respect.







7. Rescuing the Helpless, Restoring Their Strength

Destitute, accident-prone and sick cattle are examined by a veterinary doctor, treated and given medicines. In our cowshed, efforts are made to cure the injured, broken legs and other serious diseases suffering from disabled cattle by treating them. When we receive information or a call, we take our rented vehicle to the accident site and provide medical care to the cattle. When some mother cows abandon their suckling calves and die from a serious illness, their calves

are taken to our facility and bottle-fed.






